InfiniBand Test Plan update for April 2012

- 1) Scientific Linux as core OS used to validate all devices for the OFA Logo
- 2) Testing structure
 - a) RHEL, SUSE, CentOS, SL, WinOFED
- 3) Concerns about RHEL – Nick
 - a) We did not have licensing so we could not use the repository and so we only could use what was on ISO
 - b) uDAPL utility was not distributed but DAPL was.
 - c) We need to get and maintained the licenses.
 - d) Update to latest releases and all the updates in the repository. We would need to document revision levels of updates.
- 4) Testing suggestions
 - a) Big cluster with a few of secondary
 - b) Slim down testing and deploy whole new OS to whole Cluster
 - c) Nick and Rupert say to stick to previous methodology
 - d) Marty likes the mixed clusters. He would like to see more RHEL
 - e) All hardware for Logo testing was in the core and the secondary used leftover hardware. This is potentially a problem
 - f) Mitko – he likes pushes the OS. But he is OK with old way
- 5) There are issues between versions and operating systems
