- 1) Dave Wyman has applied the patch supplied by Steve Wise to several systems including PPC and x86_64 and the Connectathon test suite now runs to completion.
- 2) The issue was that the different platforms were not negotiate proper size of the message because the page sizes are different on a x86 and a PPC.

They seem to be fairly similar but Edward prefers conformance – FrameMaker does not recognize conformance so Rupert Changed it to compliance.
