- Report writing has just begun and UNH-IOL team is working to get those out to all members ASAP.
- Glenn reminded vendors that once vendors have received their reports, they have a two week period to file for arbitration. They also must provide UNH-IOL with their explicit confirmation to post the report online within this same two week period of time.
