### **Bug 2494 - Dave**

- 1) The problem is when an IBM PPC mounts a share and runs the Connectathon tests. It fails at 1 MB and reboots the client x86. There is a work around if you manually adjust rsize and wsize. See the notes in [Bug 2494](#). Steve Wise still thinks it is PPC issue.
- 2) The issue appears with Mellanox and Emulex cards. With default parameters it occurs on both by changing parameters it has different effect.
