 - Reports should be reviewed and we will address issues during the April debug event for a logo round after 3.18 GA drops planned early summer 2015
 - Dean says Emulex is on board with this plan, there were no objections

April 2015 Interop Debug Event

- Test Plan updates are being drafted in preparation for the Debug
 - OpenMPI installation and test procedure
 - RoCE Link Init Procedure
 - iSER need to identify a Target and test process. There is currently a very basic skeleton
- Drafts to be reviewed in progress during the event and vendor feedback will be important as we run through the debugging.

- Cluster VPN access is available by request for vendors in advance of the event.

Dave UNH-IOL: In the EWG minutes there has been a lot of activity in NFSoRDMA. I did not raise this in the call but would like the IWG to think about a new test suite for NFSoRDMA interop testing. Historically we have used connectathon, but connectathon.org no longer exists so we should look into a new test suite that is current and maintained. What do vendors use to test the NFSoRDMA implementations?
